



Environmental Policy

The Directors have formulated an Environmental Management System, within the requirements of the British Standard ISO 14001 to control resource processes, installations, removals and waste disposal, to enhance the interrelationship of all factors that will achieve improvement in overall environmental performance in the business activities of the organisation.

The Environmental Management System is designed to:

- (a) Provide for the efficient procurement of materials from supply sources which support the policy of environmental conservation and protection;
- (b) Constantly review and implement new working procedures to ensure all work processes and applications are within the environmental and energy utilisation recommendations of manufacturers and in compliance objectives of prevailing legislation and the British Standard ISO 14001;
- (c) Make provision for suitable controls on work applications which cause or promote the emission of dust, odours, smoke, hazardous waste and/or any other unacceptable environmental and energy waste conditions including the planned safe and tidy disposal of all waste to an approved location that makes provision, wherever possible for recycling of waste materials;
- (d) Ensure the aspects of the Company's work activities that impact on the environment are controlled and managed to minimize the effects on the environment
- (e) Promote employee input and output communication throughout the organisation that will contribute to management decisions for harmonisation in the overall environment.

The company's Environmental Management System is subject to internal and external auditing assessment, by competent persons, as part of management's continuing commitment to improvements for the prevention of pollution and the commitment for compliance with all legal and regulatory requirements in all spheres of operational activity.

To support the company's objectives the Directors have appointed a Safety & Environmental Manager with executive responsibility for the operation of the Environmental Management System and its continuing effectiveness and improvement.
